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**H&I:** The state of the H&I is strong. However we need other committed addicts help carry the message! If you don't know H&I you don't know what you are missing!

Over the past few years of a few individuals some from our fellowship and some from other fellowships, that have gone into various facilities and said they were from NA. However they were not part of H&I . At times their efforts although coming from a pure place, has created confusion, mistrust and has worked counter to the H&I effort. If you want to carry the NA message that is great, come join us, coordinate with us. We have resources that can be used. Remember what we can do together is so much more than what we can do alone. We welcome any addict who wants to get involved. If you are interested the H&I committee meets at the Frontier restaurant the Monday following area (the 2nd Saturday) at 6-7pm. It is very important that NA as a whole has one voice at the various facilities. We follow direction and if a problem arises the H&I Chair will be made aware so the problem can be addressed.

H&I has been working and coordinating with the Bosque area for the past several years and that has been working well. We are carrying the message of Hope to 10 different institutions multiple times each month! We are carrying the message **to Desert Hills, Sequoia, Matts, Turquoise Lodge and SAC, the Men's Recovery in Los Luna's and Los Luna's Level 1 correction facilities , MDC, YDC Boys and Good Shepard** each week. All facility coordinators and panel leaders are requested to show up at our monthly H&I meeting at the Frontier. This is when we can find a good fit for our new members and address any issue that has surfaced. And distribute the H&I Lit...

At this time, as chair I have been made aware of several requests to commit to new meeting. MDC again has asked us to facilitate a Woman's meeting. The MATTs facility wants us to commit to a meeting and rumors that the Sandoval detention facility wants a NA meeting. However we don't have enough warm bodies to fulfill their request.

I want to mention to the fellowship complacency is what is holding us back. H&I is strong and our members are doing a great job but we can do more if more of us commit. If you want to join us and only have a little time or not a lot of time off of paper- we have meeting you can go to. We have room for any addict who want to get involved. If you are interested show up at our monthly meeting at the Frontier restaurant. When? The Monday following area (the 2nd Saturday) at 6-7pm.

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**Outreach:** Wow! Last month was fantastic!

Outreach went to several meetings out of town and it was great. We went to Rio Rancho, Bernalillo, Jemez, Belen, Laguna and Gallup. As well as supporting several local meetings. Big month of gratitude!

Not including Outreach attendees, in Jemez Springs there were 4 in attendance, in Rio Rancho there were 12-15, Belen had 8, Gallup had 6, and Laguna had 1. We were well received everywhere we went, I introduced myself and let the chairpersons know we are here if they need anything!

I would like to request fuel reimbursement at the not for profit rate of .34 cents per gallon. I am only requesting reimbursement for the Jemez and Laguna trip, that is 206.4 miles out of the 617.8 miles traveled out of town and back. After the \$25 dollar Outreach money that leaves \$45.17 requested reimbursement. The following is a break down of miles traveled per trip via Google maps.
