There were two issues that day. The first issue was the Porta-Potties did not show up until after the event started. I asked the contact for Central New Mexico Pumping to discuss a discount with them, however I was told it was inappropriate because they are normally \$100 each and we paid \$108 for two and that they had been great in the past. I disagree and have done some research and have found porta-potties for \$65 each this would be about \$20 more for both. I am suggesting that we discontinue use of Central New Mexico Pumping and use a company that we can hold accountable. The second issue was, after I left the BBQ the person selling water and soda's was told by another committee member to give the rest of them away, these should have been saved for the next event.

The Activities Committee had not giving the donation of \$20 requested by University Heights Methodist Church for the Valentine's Day event. This was paid with an apology and the receipt was mailed.

Activities have decided to have a World Unity Day, we are still working out the details but we are requesting \$50 for the link. Early morning Sunday September 1<sup>st</sup> we will hold the meeting followed by a potluck brunch, be sure to save that date. We will provide coffee and sell soda, water, and juice boxes. The details will be updated with a flier soon.

Activities have decided to do the annual Labor Day Picnic, we are not sure where yet, that will be decided at the August Activities meeting. It will be at potluck BBQ and have two 30 minute speakers.
